What's involved:

- You can expect a call from a representative from EFFC in early November to answer questions and, for participating schools, to arrange the delivery of the toonie collection jug, student reminder stickers and instructions.
- Toonie collection jugs and stickers will be delivered to the schools the week before (Nov 9 to 13) or when arranged with the EFFC rep.
- A classroom or an assembly presentation to students about the food bank and the issue of hunger in our community can be arranged through our Community Engagement coordinator by calling Christina Philips directly at 905-837-2650 x225.
- **VALUABLE RESOURCE!** An educational resource on hunger in our community will be available on-line for teachers at www.edenfoodbank.org/schools to use with their students. There are four sections for different grade levels: primary, junior, intermediate and senior. Each section has a grade-appropriate lesson plan for teachers and a student handbook with related activities. Additional resources include a PowerPoint presentation and hunger profile using an updated survey and statistical data.
- The EFFC Toonie Tuesday Parent Letter can be sent home with students the week before to explain the event and encourage student participation.
- Stickers are available for all students as reminders in their student handbooks.
- Toonie Tuesday is on Tuesday, November 17th. Toonies can be collected by classroom or during an assembly.
- Collection of the toonie collection jugs will take place the week of November 17th, or the next week. An exact pick-up time can be arranged with your EFFC rep or by calling the food bank directly at 905-837-2650 x225.
