We would like to encourage you to participate in our 11th annual Toonie Tuesday campaign to raise much-needed funds for your local food bank.

Eden Food for Change provides access to food, advocacy, education, skills training and other assistance to hungry families in western Mississauga.

Every week we see new families show up because they don't have the resources to pay the bills *and* put food on the table. There are **400 families** that come **every month** to visit our food bank because the adults are having trouble finding work, or finding work that pays a living wage. This means that women, men and children need us. In fact, **more than 40% of people who use our food bank are children.**

With your help, we are able to provide people with a variety of food, including healthy, fresh food such as milk, eggs and fruits and vegetables.

By donating a toonie on Tuesday, November 17th, you will help us provide the good food needed for a family of four to make a healthy, nutritious meal. You read that right; **just \$2 will help feed 4 people!** Your support will feed a local family.

Both school boards will once again join forces to help this local endeavor. While we understand the constant pressure to raise funds for worthwhile causes throughout the world, we ask you to consider Eden Food for Change because it has an immediate impact on your own neighbourhood.
